
Are you a pet lover? Do you enjoy working with pets? If you are then it may be worth considering getting into the pet-care business or something related to pets. The market is booming.





How to Properly Clean Your Cell

Items Needed:

Water (H20)

Chemicals, Shampoo, or Crystal Clean.

Any of these will work, but for maximum results a little bit of each of them mixed in a bottle works the best.

Broom and Dustpan

Two old towels. One for the floor and one for your sink, walls and table.

The reason you don't want to use the day room mop is because you'll be spreading more hair inside of your cell than you already have. This is counterproductive as far as germs and mildew are concerned as well.

Estimated Time: 10 to 15 minutes

Instructions: First and fore-

out of the way in general.

- 1) Pick up everything off of the floor. Place all of the items collected either on your bunk or outside of your cell against the wall.
- 2) Sweep the entire cell. Make a special effort to get under the bunk and in all of the cracks and corners. You will even want to sweep your porch (in front of the cell door). Sweep everything into a dust pan and throw it into the garbage can located in the dayroom.
- 3) Take your sink towel and the bottle containing the mixture of cleaner, and run water over the towel and add cleaner. Then, use the towel to wipe your sink, mirror, table, and every now and then your walls.
- 4) As crazy as it may seem, dip most, to be considerate or your floor towel in the toilet and pour some more cleaner on the

cellmate try to do it when he is towel and toilet. Then, start at rec, watching television, or scrubbing your toilet inside and out. (Be sure not to flush when the towel is in the toilet.) Rinse the towel and flush the dirty water.

- 5) Pour more cleaning chemicals on your toilet and floor, and use your towel as a mop. Get down like Cinderella and scrub the floor and under your bunk. If you cannot bend over or get under the bunk easily; use the broom stick to work the towel like a mop.
- 6) Rinse out all towels and lay them out to dry. Turn your fan on, use it to dry your floor.
- 7) Put everything back where it goes in nice orderly stacks.

If you do this to your cell every three days; every time you do it from then on it will be less to clean up.





THE DAY AFTER ROSWELL:

A Former Pentagon Official Reveals The U.S. Government' Shocking UFO Cover-up Col. Philip J. Corso (Ret.) Available in the general library



Whether or not you believe in UFOs or alien visitors, you may find yourself concluding that something extraordinary did indeed happen in that New Mexico desert many years ago. The U.S. Army's deepest and most guarded secret actually occurred on that night.

On July 4, 1947, Independence Day, a delta shaped aircraft crashed during a lightning storm in Roswell, New Mexico. The Army had been tracking this object for over an hour.
